Alvin Ailey II

Objective: to facilitate an educational program for teenaged girls (ages 14-17) that covers a liberal arts overview, modern dance & Alvin Ailey history and to sponsor this group to attend a performance of Alvin Ailey II at the Folly Theater in the Fall of 2015 Kansas City, MO.

Program Outline

Phase 1

Pre-Assessment: Girls will participate in a baseline activity that will gauge her individual understanding of the liberal arts, the modern dance movement and Alvin Ailey.

Phase 2

Arts Education: Girls will learn the definition of the liberal arts, modern dance and will independently research the history of Alvin Ailey.

Phase 3

Theater at a Glance: Girls will participate in tour of the venue to learn what to expect at the performance. Girls will also discuss appropriate attire during this phase.

Phase 4

Ailey Performance: Girls will attend a performance of Alvin Ailey or Alvin Ailey II.

Phase 5

Written Assessment: Girls will write a 1-page reflection paper (MLA format) on her reaction to the performance.

Phase 6

Post-Assessment: Girls will retake the pre-assessment.

Phase 7

LEM Foundation: Data will be processed and shared with R.U.B.I.E.S. INC.

LEM will coordinate with R.U.B.I.E.S. INC to develop an acceptable timeline.


Program Cost
